Live Surgery: Robot-assisted radical prostatectomy– the sleeve technique

Dr. Jörn Witt, MD, is the Chair of the Department of Urology, Pediatric Urology and Urologic Oncology at St. Antonius-Hospital Gronau, since April 2002, one of the biggest urological departments in Germany. Dr. Witt is also director of the Prostate Center Northwest, a certified Comprehensive Cancer Center for prostate cancer diagnostic and treatment and a tertiary referral center for surgery in urologic oncology. He is one of Europe's leading robotic surgeons with a personal experience of more than 7500 radical prostatectomies and head of a very busy surgical center with over 2000 robotic procedures per year. Dr. Witt additionally has a broad experience in all other urological robotic procedures, is Co-Founder of the German Society for Robotic Urology (Deutsche Gesellschaft für roboterassistierte Urologie) and was president of several scientific meetings.
